



## ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME PARTICIPANTS GRADUATE

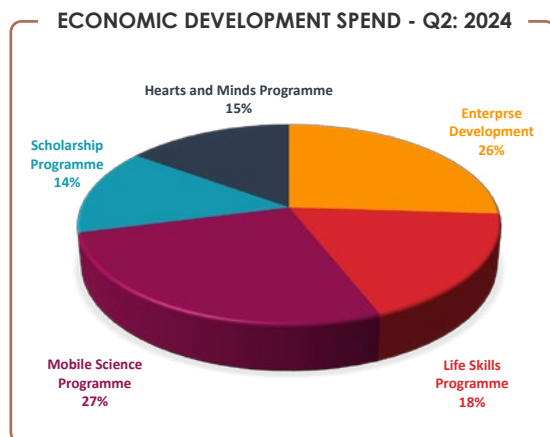
