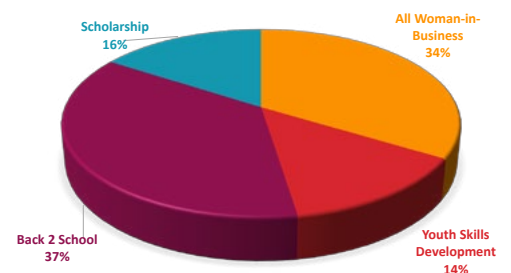


APPLY NOW: ALL WOMEN-IN-BUSINESS EMPOWERMENT INITIATIVE
